FUNDING

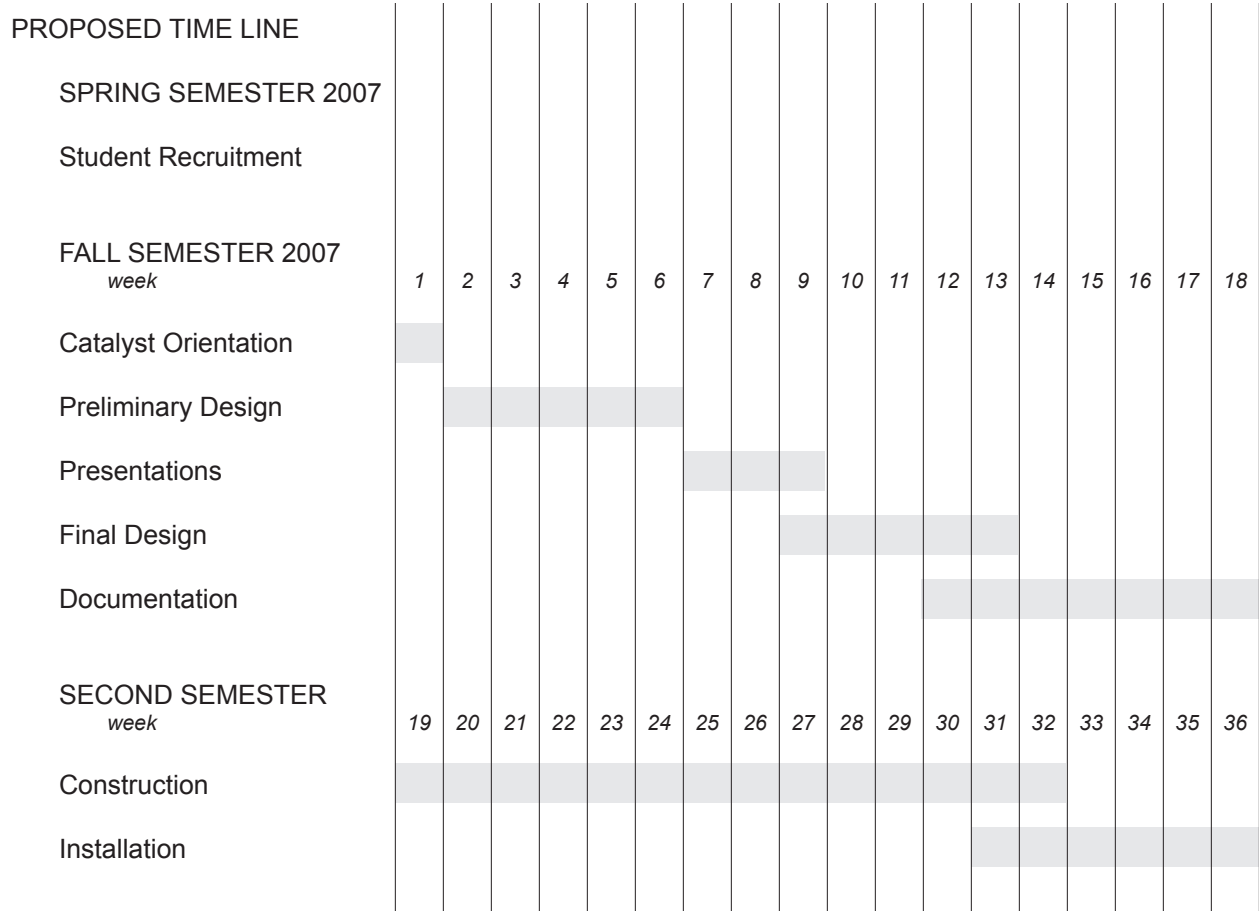
Catalyst will provide the following funding:

COURSE SUMMARY

- c. Those on the construction team will participate at a lesser hourly requirement the first semester, and have a higher hourly requirement the second semester.
- d. Responsibilities of the students will include design, documentation, public presentation, construction and installation.
